## PFE Point Values

Each dart must score full value

- 1 Pt = Singles Win** ('01 or Cricket)
- 1 Pt = 100 – 139** ('01)
- 1 Pt = 3 Dart Out** ('01)
- 1 Pt = 2 Trips** (Cricket)
- 1 Pt = 3 Bulls** (Cricket)
- 2 Pts = 140 – 169** (501)
- 2 Pts = 2-3 Dart Double Out 100-139** ('01)
- 2 Pts = 2-3 Dart Double In 100-139** (601 only)
- 2 Pts = 7 Count** (Cricket)
- 2 Pts = 4 Bulls** (Cricket)
- 3 Pts = 170-180** ('01)
- 3 Pts = 3 Dart Double Out 140-169** ('01)
- 3 Pts = 3 Dart Double In 140-169** (601 only)
- 3 Pts = 3 Trips** (Cricket)
- 3 Pts = 5 Bulls** (Cricket)
- 4 Pts = 3 Dart Double Out 170** ('01)
- 4 Pts = 3 Dart Double In 170** (601 only)
- 4 Pts = 6 Bulls** (Cricket)

In a Cricket Game

- \* It should be noted that the **FIRST** priority is to win the game/match for the team. With this in mind, PFE points are noteworthy shots and may vary as per the experience of the players and division.
- \* All PFE points must be thrown and properly noted on the scoresheet at the time they are shot. Previous PFE shots, which were not recorded when shot, are not to be listed unless the opponent confirms and agrees. They cannot be arbitrated with the league scorekeeper at a later date.
- \* Cricket PFE points must count full value in order to be recorded.
- \* A PFE Point is awarded to the winner of Singles games ('01 AND Cricket) only if they actually play the game, PFEs are NOT awarded if the thrower wins by forfeit.
- \* PFE points count only in regular season league play and not during post season. Patches will be awarded during the postseason only if properly noted on the scoresheet.
- \* The PFE Leader at the end of the season will receive an award.
